LAUNCH OF CONTAINER TRACK AND TRACE SERVICE

All NTP users can now use a new Container Track and Trace Service on the Networked Trade Platform (NTP) to obtain visibility of trade between Singapore and China, starting with Port of Singapore¹ and two China ports, namely Yangshan port (Shanghai) and Qinzhou port (Guangxi).

2 The service allows Singapore-based traders and logistics supply chain partners to monitor the status and location of containerized shipments quickly and easily. It enables businesses to see the location or status of a particular container at one glance to facilitate their supply chain and logistic planning.

Events shared through the service

3 There are three major categories of information that will be available on this service. Firstly, vessel events such as vessel arrival and departure times. Next is key container events such as gate-in/gate-out and loaded/discharged. The last category pertains to customs-related information such as the permit approval and customs release.

Using the service

4 The service is available to all NTP users including NTP-LITE account users, and at no additional cost. Information on how to set up your NTP account can be found at <u>www.ntp.gov.sg</u> (Get Started > Accessing NTP > <u>Sign in with Singpass</u>).

5 Once your NTP account has been set up, you can sign in to the NTP to access the Container Track and Trace service and retrieve the status of a particular container by keying in the container number.
