Background

Circular No. 30/2000 – Duty-unpaid Motor Vehicles (MV) may be removed from LWVs for <u>up</u> to 1 month without Customs' prior approval for :

- a) Display at showrooms
- b) Minor works at workshops
- c) LTA Inspections





Circular No. 4/2012 – Duty-unpaid Motor Vehicles (MV) may be removed from LWVs for <u>up to 1 month for LWV Type I licensees</u> and <u>up to 3 months for LWV Type II/III</u> <u>licensees</u>, without Customs' prior approval for approved exhibitions.



Need for Clarification

- Unclear definition of 'showrooms' and 'approved exhibitions'
- Licensees write in to seek approval/inform Customs for all movement of duty-unpaid motor vehicles to unlicensed premises, such as workshops, showrooms and LTA inspections etc.





Revised facilitation granted

- Removal of duty-unpaid vehicles to *licensed showroom under the same licence number* without Customs' approval
- Removal of duty-unpaid vehicles for *LTA inspection* for up to 1 month without Customs' approval







Revised facilitation granted (cont'd)

- Submit temporary removal application (approval granted on case-by-case basis) via Annex A forms to Customs_APS for temporary removal of duty-unpaid vehicles to any <u>exhibitions, unlicensed showrooms/premises, and minor</u> <u>works at workshops</u>; and submit Annex B forms upon the return of the vehicles to LWV
- Revised facilitation will be re-issued in separate circular and will supersede Circular No. 30/2000 and Circular No. 4/2012
