1. Overview of Export Licensing System

Operate an export licensing system in accordance with international standards

- Control the export of items that have high potential of being diverted into weapons, in accordance with the four international export control regimes so as to protect international peace and national security
- **Legal grounds** : Foreign Trade Act, Public Notice on Trade of Strategic Items, Defense Acquisition Program Act, Nuclear Safety Act, etc.
- **Strategic items** : Any goods, software and technology that have high potential of being appropriated for manufacturing, developing or using weapons of mass destruction or conventional weapons.



1. Overview of Export Licensing System

Operate an export licensing system in accordance with international standards

- Licensing Agencies : Licensing agencies vary by controlled item type

	Agency	Item Type
Licensing Agencies	MOTIE	Dual-use
	NSSC	Nuclear use
	DAPA	Military use

"" "Ensure expertise in license review by separating licensing responsibilities by controlled item type"

- **License types** : Individual License, Comprehensive License, Catch-all License, Brokering License, Transit/Transshipment License
- Licensing procedures
 - Classification \rightarrow License application \rightarrow Review \rightarrow Approval or denial



2. Export Licensing Procedures

Classification of items

- Companies apply for **professional classification or self classification** through YESTRADE system
 - Self-classification : Enter item information on YESTRADE self-classification system and submit answers to questions on specifications → Immediately check if the item falls under the category of strategic items on the system and have the classification result issued
 - Professional classification : Provide detailed information about an item via YESTRADE professional classification system → KOSTI's technical experts determine whether the item constitutes a controlled strategic item free of charge and issue the classification result



2. Export Licensing Procedures

Thorough examination

- Companies apply for export licenses, selecting items and export license types via
 YESTRADE
- Licensing officers **review basic documents**, **the exporter and counterparty**(end-user) against assessment criteria → **Issue an export license** through YESTRADE
- Applicants are able to check the progress of license review in **real time, informed of supplementary documents to submit** and receive examination results, all on YESTRADE

Assessment Criteria

Classification result, Importer, Importer's technological levels & military and diplomatic sensitivity, Usage by the private sector, Reliability of the purpose of use by the buyer, ultimate consignee and end user, Possibility of re-exportation, Whether the exporter, buyer, ultimate consignee or end user is included in Denial list, etc.



3. Post Control

Illegal export of strategic items is subject to strict penalties according to Foreign Trade Act

Penalties

• Criminal : Up to 7 years of imprisonment or a fine of up to five times the value of the transaction, or both

Administrative : Prohibition on trade of strategic items for up to 3 years, order to receive training and education, etc.
