### **Republic Act No. 10697**

### Strategic Trade Management Act (STMA)

"An act preventing the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction by managing the trade in strategic goods, the provision of related services, and for other purposes"



### **National Strategic Goods List**



#### **CATCH-ALL CONTROLS**

- Goods or services may be used for **WMDs or their means of delivery**.
- Country of destination is subject to an international sanction/ arms embargo and goods may be used for military end-use.
- Goods may be **used as parts/ components of military items** that have been exported without a license.
- **Exporter knows or suspects** that the unlisted goods may be used for a) or b).

Imprisonment for a period of *six* (6) years and one (1) day to twelve (12) years, and a fine from one million pesos (P1,000,000.00) to five million pesos (P5,000,000.00)

Cancellation/ suspension of authority to operate with SEC/ DTI



Imprisonment for a period of *six* (6) months and one (1) day to six (6) years, and a fine from one hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00) to one million pesos (P1,000,000.00)

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### **Elements of an Effective ICP**



#### MANAGEMENT COMMITMENT

The commitment and support given by the management to comply with the STMA and its IRR.



#### ICP STRUCTURE AND RESPONSIBILITY

The composition and arrangement of personnel in implementing the ICP tasked in implementing the ICP.



#### **TECHNOLOGY CONTROL PLAN, if applicable**

A system designed to prevent unauthorized access, transmission, transfer or sharing of sensitive and controlled items, software, and technology.



#### **REPORTING AND CORRECTIVE ACTION**

A system for reporting incidents or acts that violate the STMA, its IRR or terms and conditions of the authorization including remedial and preventive measures intended to avoid violations.



#### SHIPMENT CONTROL

A system that prevents diversion of strategic goods as they are transferred from one country to another.



### **Elements of an Effective ICP**



#### SCREENING PROCEDURES

Company's procedure for commodity classification, end-use/ end-user screening, and risk assessment.



#### **ICP TRAINING**

Skills/ knowledge development in preparation for tasks concerning strategic trade management or ICP.



#### **INTERNAL AUDIT**

The process whereby a company assesses its ICP

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#### ICP STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE

Contains the detailed procedure that must be followed to ensure compliance with the ICP's rules and policies.



#### RECORDKEEPING

A system by which a company maintains records of its transactions.

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 20-26 Series of 2020

#### SUBJECT: GUIDELINES ON EXPORT AUTHORIZATION

WHEREAS, according to Section 8 of Republic Act No. 10687, otherwise known as the Strategic Trade Management Act (STMA), the Strategic Trade Management Office (STMO) is created as a bureau under the administrative supervision of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) to serve as the executive and technical agency of the national government for the establishment of the management systems for the trade in strategic goods.

WHEREAS, under Section 3 of the STMA, the following activities shall be subject to an authorization issued by the STMO: export, import, transit, transshipment, re-export, reassignment, and the provision of related services.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the STMA creates a National Strategic Goods List (NSGL), which describes with specificity the strategic goods subject to authorization. The NSGL is composed of three (3) annexes: Military Goods (Annex 1), Dual-Use Goods (Annex 2), and the Nationally Controlled Goods (Annex 3).

WHEREAS, Section 9(d) of the STMA vest the STMO with the power and function to issue or deny issuance of authorizations for the trade of strategic goods and the provision of related services.

WHEREAS, under the Department Administrative Order (DAO) 19-07, the STMO shall adopt a phased implementation of the activities under the STMA, starting with the registration of stakeholders and followed by export authorization.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Circular is hereby issued for the information, guidance, and compliance of all covered persons.

1. Start of Export Authorization

The STMO shall start accepting export authorization applications from STMAregistered persons on 01 July 2020.

2. Regulated Activities

Export refers to the following activities:

- 2.1. An actual shipment of strategic goods out of the Philippines (Fig. 1); or
- 2.2. Transmission of software and technology (Fig. 2) via:
