### Expansion of Singapore's Transhipment and Transit Control Lists

#### **Strategic Goods (Control) Regulations**

Gazetted on 25 Feb 2019 Effective from **1 May 2019** 

Fourth Schedule (Transhipment) Fifth Schedule (Transit)



134 product category codes require permits for transhipment and transit through Singapore

# **Examples of New Controls**

- Explosive, TKX-50 (Dihydroxylammonium 5,5'bistetrazole-1,1'-diolate); and energetic material, thermites (ML8.a.43 and ML8.c.12.)
- Target assemblies and components for the production of tritium (1B235)
- Prefabricated repair assemblies (2B350.k.)
- Biological manufacturing equipment, nucleic acid assemblers and synthesisers (2B352)
- Electric components, "Non-volatile memories" (3A001.a.2.), electro-optical modulators (3A001.i.),
- Rocket motor cases and insulation components and nozzles (9A106.b.)



## **Examples of Controls Removed**

- Water-hydrogen sulphide exchange tray columns (1B229)
- Technology: Interactive graphics (2E003.a.), Development of generators of machine tool instructions (2E003.d.)
- EEPROMs, flash memories and Magnetic Random access memories (MRAMs) (3A001.a.2.)
- Cameras: high speed cinema recording cameras (6A003.a.1.), mechanical high speed cameras (6A003.a.2.), mechanical streak cameras (6A003.a.3.)

#### Amendments to Seventh Schedule of the Regulation of Imports & Exports Regulations



### **Commercial Goods with DPRK Prohibited**

 With effect from 8 Nov 2017, Singapore has prohibited all commercially traded goods from or to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), including the transhipment and transit of these goods through Singapore.

Seventh Schedule of the Regulations of Imports and Exports Regulations:

<u>"Any goods that are for the purposes of trade with any person</u> <u>in the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK)</u>" is prohibited from import, export, transshipment and transit.
